He holds a Doctorate in Transformational Leadership (Bakke Graduate University- Dallas, Texas), Master's in Education Planning Management and Supervision (University of Guyana), Post Graduate Diploma in Education Administration (University of Guyana), Bachelors Social Science-Sociology (University of Guyana), Bachelor Arts-Theology (Caribbean School of Theology) and Trained Class 1 Grade 1 Teachers' Certificate (Cyril Potter College of Education).

Dr. Hutson has served in the Ministry of Education, Guyana, as a District Education Officer, Regional Education Officer, Principal Education Officer, Assistant Chief Education Officer, Deputy Chief Education Officer (Development), and Chief Education Officer, during which he managed education delivery nationwide. He is now the Executive Director of the National Accreditation Council, Guyana, and Professor of Servant Leadership and Global Education Leadership at the Bakke Graduate University (BGU), Dallas, Texas. He enjoys public speaking, reading, research, and sports.

Additionally, Dr. Hutson takes a special interest in seeing young people, in particular, fulfil their God-given potential, which has resulted in the publication of several books, including *Born to Succeed*, *Issues and Reflections on Missions, Leadership and Education*, *"Quotes" and Interpretations from the Heart*, *The Diary of a Warlock Man* and *Shades of Business*.

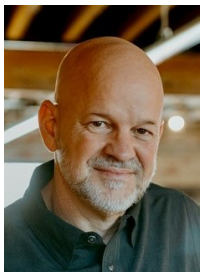
